9th Grade Admission Requirements Students currently attending <u>Catholic</u> Elementary Schools

<u>Policy</u>: Prospective students who wish to apply to Immaculata-La Salle High School are invited to visit the school during Open House. All students must be in good standing with their previous school. Prospective students may not have any disciplinary problems at their previous school.

Requirements: All students applying to Immaculata-La Salle should be fluent in verbal and written English. Immaculata-La Salle does not offer English as a Second Language (ESOL) or special education programs.

The admissions process for all incoming students entails:

- 1. Complete the online Entrance Exam application.
- 2. Pay the online application fee for Entrance Exam.
- 3. Upload a copy of the student's birth certificate.
- 4. Signed Release of Records Form uploaded to the online application.
- 5. If the applicant is currently receiving extended time or any other accommodation, a current and complete psycho-educational evaluation must be submitted. The psycho-educational report must be from a licensed psychologist and must be within a three-year validity period. In addition, if the student has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), a copy should be submitted for their file.
- 6. Pastor Recommendation Form is to be requested via the online application form.

In addition to the entrance exam scores, supplemental academic records will be required to complete the admission process in a timely manner.

Please be aware that <u>Immaculata-La Salle High School</u> will request this information directly from Catholic schools and parishes within the Archdiocese of Miami.

- \bullet 6th and 7th grades final grades
- 8th grade 1st semester report card
- Standardized Tests Scores for 6th, 7th, and 8th grades (Terranova, SAT, etc.)
- Principal's recommendation

Admission decisions will take place throughout the month of January for all students whose files are complete. If deemed necessary, an interview may be requested before a final decision is made. If an interview is required, you will be notified ahead of time. Please be aware that all interviews will be scheduled during school hours and proof of attendance will be provided to the student to turn in to his/her current school.

Decision letters will be mailed in late January. Early decisions or notifications are not permitted per the Archdiocese of Miami, Department of Schools.

Registration will take place the week following the mailing of the admissions' decisions. Placement exam details will be included in the admissions package.
