

Requirements for TRI-M Music Honors Society: records checked mid-January after Semester 1

GRADE LEVEL: Sophomores – Seniors: **students must complete an application process**

Transfers: Must have completed one semester of Music at ILS

GPA: At least a 3.0 average in music courses as well as in other academic subjects.

COURSES /Music Participation: Enrolled in a school-sponsored music ensemble and/or class for at least two semesters. Academic Achievement.

CHARACTER:

1. disciplinary and attendance records show no consistent, willful, or flagrant violations of school rules and expectations
2. a deep interest or passion for Music: performing, engaging, reviewing, analyzing, or serving.
