

Requirements for Spanish Honor Society

GRADE LEVEL: Sophomores – Juniors – Seniors

Transfers: Must have completed one semester at ILS

GPA: 3.5 career un-weighted adjusted

COURSES: One year of high school Spanish is required.

CHARACTER:

1. disciplinary and attendance records show no consistent, willful, or flagrant violations of school rules and expectations
2. recommendations from teachers/administrators/moderators/coaches

Obligations of Spanish Honor Society membership:

Maintain criteria for GPA and Character and attend meetings during the year

A regularly enrolled student of a secondary school (grades 10-12) who has maintained an honor average in the study of Spanish or Portuguese for at least three semesters is eligible for membership in the Society. Sponsors should also include character, leadership, seriousness of purpose, cooperation, honesty, service and commitment to others in the criteria for selection into the Society. The student must be enrolled in the study of the language at the time of initiation.

The student membership fee payable before initiation is established by the National Council. Each student member will receive a Certificate of Membership.

If a member does not continue the study of Spanish or Portuguese, the student may remain in the Society as an Associate Member until graduation at the discretion of the Chapter Sponsor.

A member may be removed from the Chapter at the discretion of the Chapter Sponsor for failure to maintain an honor average, misconduct or insubordination or other serious infraction.

All members must attend the meetings hold for the Spanish Honor Society. If a student fails to attend more than 3 meetings, he/she will lose it membership.

PROJECTS: Students will help, facilitate, create and/or organize the “Feria Latina”

To graduate with Spanish Honor society’s honor cords and all obligations of membership must be met by April 1st of Senior year.
