

Requirements for SNHS membership: records checked mid-January after Semester 1

GRADE LEVEL: Students must be in the last two years of secondary school education, but exceptional sophomore students can be accepted into a chapter.

GPA: 3.6000 career un-weighted adjusted

COURSES: 3.600 career simple average in all Science courses (core and elective)

CHARACTER: Student must maintain behavior that is acceptable to the guidelines as outlined by the school's code of conduct in the student handbook of their educational institution.

EXPERIENCE: Student must be enrolled in an honors or AP science class prior the year of induction.

Obligations of SNHS membership:

Maintain criteria for GPA and Character and attend meetings during the year

MEETINGS: Attendance is required. Seniors must attend a minimum of 6 meetings. Juniors must attend a minimum of 7 meetings.

COURSES: A member must be enrolled in at least one honors level science class prior to the eleventh-grade year. A member must be enrolled in at least one second year honors science class during or prior to the twelfth-grade year. A member must be enrolled in at least one upper-level science class during the twelfth-grade year. If second year honors or upper-level science courses are not offered by the school, then the student must be enrolled in a second first year honors or upper-level science class.

PARTICIPATION:

1. All members must attend one local chapter officer's lecture annually. All lectures must be approved by the chapter's advisor before being presented. Regular members may give a lecture with the chapter advisor's approval.
2. All members shall participate in two or more projects per year. The purpose of the projects shall be to encourage scientific and intellectual thought, to further the knowledge of science in school and community, and to volunteer in the surrounding community.
3. Each chapter shall either judge or host a local science fair contest and/or assist in the creation and/or maintenance of a science club at the school and/or assist fellow students' success in their science classes.
4. Members must complete four hours of service per school year to keep their membership.

To graduate with SNHS honor cords all obligations of membership must be met by April 1st of Senior year.
