

## **Requirements for NEHS membership:** records checked mid-January after Semester 1

**GRADE LEVEL:** Sophomores – Seniors: **students must complete an application process**

**Transfers:** Must have completed one semester of English at ILS

**GPA:** 3.7000 career un-weighted adjusted

**COURSES:** 3.500 career simple average in all English courses (core and elective)

**CHARACTER:**

1. disciplinary and attendance records show no consistent, willful, or flagrant violations of school rules and expectations
2. recommendations from teachers/administrators/moderators/coaches
3. a deep interest or passion for English: the written or spoken word, reading, writing, storytelling

**Some examples:**

**LANGUAGE ARTS:**

1. Electives chosen in the English department
2. Competitions entered for writing, poetry, etc.
3. Extra-curricular activities involving English language or literature
4. Positions in clubs that involve media or publicity
5. Tutoring for English
6. Membership in Drama Club and/or Debate Club

## **Obligations of NEHS membership:**

**Maintain criteria for GPA and Character and attend meetings during the year**

**MEETINGS:** Attendance is required. Two absences in a row and/or failure to participate in the life of the society and its projects will result in dismissal.

**ACTIVITIES:**

- Organize and run English tutoring lab
- Enter submissions into competitions for writing, poetry, etc.
- Contribute to school publications: *The Royal Courier*, *iNKLINGS*, etc.
- Run at least one society project for the year from among what is voted:  
Book drive; Blind Date with a Book; Library; Poetry Month;  
Coffee House; Shakespeare's Birthday; Carpe Diem Day....
