

Requirements for Mu Alpha Theta (Math Honor Society) membership:
records checked mid-January after Semester 1

GRADE LEVEL: Incoming Sophomores – Incoming Seniors

Transfers: Must have completed one semester of Mathematics at ILS

GPA: minimum 3.5 overall unweighted GPA

COURSES: B+ (87) career simple average in all Mathematics courses (core and elective)

CHARACTER: 1. disciplinary and attendance records show no consistent, willful, or
flagrant violations of school rules and expectations
2. recommendations from current and former mathematics teachers
3. a deep interest or passion for Mathematics

REQUIREMENTS

for invitation:

1. Minimum 3.5 average Algebra I – higher
2. Completed Geometry, Algebra II and currently enrolled (or set to enroll) in Pre-Calculus Honors, AP Precalculus, Calculus Honors, or AP Calculus.
3. Two consecutive years of Honors/Pre-AP math courses
4. Current/former math teacher recommendations – must be an asset to the class.
5. If recommendations come back as “maybe”, there is potential for an Interview.

Obligations of MAO membership:

Maintain criteria for GPA and Character and attend meetings during the year

MEETINGS: Attendance is required. Two absences in a row and/or failure to participate in the life of the society and its projects will result in dismissal.

REQUIREMENTS: 1. **Sophomores and Juniors-** Complete at least 20 tutoring hours in MathLab per year (10 per semester)
Seniors- Complete at least 16 tutoring hours in MathLab per year (8 per semester)
2. Attend monthly Mu Alpha Theta meetings and participate in all events (PI Day and calculator workshops)
3. Be asset to your math classroom
4. Maintain good disciplinary standing
5. Payment of initial dues (\$25 – includes shirt and membership)
6. Maintain minimum B+ average in current Math course

To graduate with MAO honor cords all obligations of membership must be met by the end of the third quarter of Senior year.
